Service at AIC Kaptombes

Dear friends and family members,

this verse in Psalm 34 shows what are the most important things in our ministry here at Kenya: That the children and youth is listening to us, not only with the ears but also with their hearts, so that they will be open to give their lives to Jesus and to serve the Lord. Till now we can they that they are very open to listen to us... but we don't know yet if they are listening with their hearts, too. The time of being here is too short to see what is in the hearts of the children and youth here.



But meanwhile we have settled after being here for five month now. But a few things are still in the very beginning.... Since almost four weeks we have a car and that has changed our everyday life a lot, because we are not always here at Kapkuikui anymore... we are moving a lot also to our partner churches at Kaptombes and Tembererwe... and we are now able to serve in the whole region much better than before...

The Sunday School and the dancing group at AIC Kapkuikui is the same like before. But the dancing group became more and more strong and very often they get invitations for our churches and even for bigger events... More and more people wanted to join the dancing group, but 35 dancers is enough... therefore in July we have started a Youth Choir at AIC Kapkuikui and also a Youth Group which is meeting on Friday afternoons..

Because we can move now we are only in the church of AIC Kapkuikui once a month. That causes some challenges for the children car during the sermon and also for the drama group at Kapkuikui because I(Dani) am not around on every Sunday like I was before... and for now I don't know who is able to be responsible for this two groups. Please pray that we will find someone who can take care that these ministries can continue



Since the end of June we still show Bible movies at the weekend, four are still on the program... and then we want to start the movie evenings at AIC Kaptombes on every Friday and Saturday. It is still amazing that still 70 to 100 people are coming and watch the English Bible Movies when they get to know: There is a cinema tonight... Please pray that through this ministry new people will come to church and that they will become interested in the Gospel and not only in the nice pictures...

Also in Kenya they have been holidays in August but only for two and a half weeks. On last Monday the work at school begun proper and now we want to expand our pastoral program (evangelistic outreach at schools). Till now we are regularly at Kapkuikui Primary School on Thursday and Friday every week. In June the Seconday School in Loboi was inviting him to lead the music program on the weekend challenge for the students.

But now we have our car and therefore we want to pass by at different school in our region and ask where we will be allowed to do the pastoral program also. Please pray that God will guide us and will open doors...

In August there as a meeting with the Sunday School Teachers in the region and we decided to do a teacher training but it didn't take place till now... But after that meeting we found out that there are 15 Sunday School in our church district for which we are responsible for... and now we want to visit one after the other....



At the holidays we made a program for three days, fort he children in the morning and the youth in the afternoon about the same issue first in Kapkuikui and then also in Kaptombes... The children were speaking about "Jonah - Obey God and he will bless you". In Kaptombes for some children it was the first time to use a pair of scissors, to make an outdoor game and to watch a movie (Jonah)... ©

With the Youth we were sharing about the "Armour of God"(Ephesians 6) and after that we played many funny games. It was an amazing fellowship, we were laughing a lot and we had lots of fun. During this week Robert also started with another dancing group at AIC Kaptombes.

Since we have the car and we are able to come we really can see how the church at Kaptombes is happy about that. The church meets in a house made from iron sheets and the benches are almost all spoiled.... But the people show a great love for us in their faces and they are so happy to have fellowship with us and that someone started to care for them also... They were so heartily welcoming us... Over 30 children and 20 youngsters were attending our holiday program at Kaptombes. And the Sunday School teachers were so happy when we were joining the Sunday School... Very spontaneous they asked Robert to preach... that happened twice for now... We are very happy about that!!!

Now we are exiting what God will do in Tembererwe when we will go there together for the first time coming Sunday.... Once Robert went by foot there for a branch service... he was reported how simple everything was there... I will see...

Last Sunday was a wedding of the pastor of AIC Kapkuikui and Robert was a member of the committee who prepared the wedding. He was responsible for the decoration and also for the music program. The dancing group was not only dancing during the service, they were also pealing potatoes, washing the hands of others..., serving the food and for tidying up afterwards... I (Dani) was responsible for fixing their uniforms before the wedding and to make a movie and pictures during the wedding ceremony... ©

It's a pity but I (Dani) am sick again... this time it is not a Malaria it is an infection of the stomach, an urinary tract infection and also a giardiasis (strong diarrhoea like water) caused by a parasite in our water which was not filtered out by our filter... Please pray especially for our health... in the last month I had two times malaria... The lakes and the sump is the hatchery of the mosquito... and we are not only staying in the house... we are moving a lot and therefore you can get mosquito bites everywhere... Please pray for God's protection for us...

Protection not only because of sicknesses also because of the many snakes on our church compound... There was a cobra in front of our house and Robber tried to kill her, but he was only hurting her with the stones... When I was phoning to my mum in Germany she started to pray that God will kill the snake... On the very next day we found the cobra under a bush next to our house... she died... because of prayer or because of loosing too much blood? That doesn't matter. Our life is in God's hand and I'm very happy when he is telling the snakes to stay far from us... and also the scorpions...  $\odot$ 

Finally we want to thank everybody of you who was helping us to get a Double Cabin Pickup, one speaker, a mixer, a projector and also a generator which we take with us to the partner churches and the outreaches and actually which made it finally possible that we can do our ministry like we are doing now... The Lord my bless you!!! Thanks also for your prayers, without them our ministry here would not have any sense ...
